Isaiah 41:10*

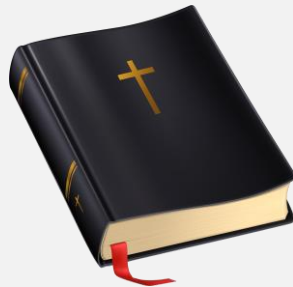
There are many people who are very confident in their own abilities, strength and wisdom. They trust in their own ideas and exude self-confidence.
